Cline Cellars Pink Truck, 2005 18

This unique North Coast California wine is a blend of Zinfandel, Grenache, and Mourvedre. It exhibits berry and citrus aromas, and strawberry, raspberry and pomegranate flavors. Juicy orange notes make for a delicious, bright finish. This is a refreshingly complex wine crafted in a balanced, off-dry style.

Valley of the Moon

Rosato di Sangiovese, 2006 27

Made from Sangiovese grapes grown in Sonoma County's Alexander Valley, this rose wine is a perfect accompaniment to lighter or summer menus. It is made in the traditional Tuscan method of harvesting the grapes at the peak of ripeness, crushing them, and allowing the juice 24 hours of skin contact before the grapes are pressed. This happy wine is crisp and refreshing with aromas of raspberry, followed by flavors of strawberry preserves and tart cherry.

Les Domaniers Ott Vin Rose 2006 34

A typical French Cotes de Provence blend of Granache, Cinsault and Syrah, this wine has a beautiful salmon hue, aromas of apricots, caramel and spices, with a balanced mouth feel. A great summer porch wine, it is even better when paired with grilled chicken and anything with a citrus flavor or aroma.
